Message from Supervisor Edward P. Romaine

I want to provide all of our veterans and their families with an update regarding Brookhaven Town's Division of Veterans Services. We have a new Veterans Services Officer serving at Town Hall and the office is continuing to see an increase in the number of veterans it assists.

Brookhaven Town's Veterans Food Drive recently ended and will provide approximately 250 grocery bags of food to veterans in need and their families. Established in 2017, this drive has generated more than 900 grocery bags of food in only three years. This year's food drive was held from June 10 through June 28, and non-perishable foods were contributed by residents and local businesses to four Town drop-off locations in Coram, Farmingville, Blue Point and Mount Sinai.

The Brookhaven Town Division of Veterans Services Office, working in a shared partnership with the Suffolk County Veterans Service Agency, has distributed 200 bags of food to veterans who visited the office and worked with local VFW representatives to distribute the contributions directly to veterans and their families. A portion of the donations are being kept at the Office of the Division of Veterans Services to distribute on an as-needed basis.

I want to thank all of our veterans for your courageous service to our country, and encourage all veterans living in Brookhaven Town and their spouses to contact our Veterans Services Officer at 631-451-6574.

After serving his country for five years in the Navy and for six years as an active reserve in the Navy, Quarter Master Petty Officer First Class (QM1) Brian Rooney is now serving veterans at Brookhaven Town Hall. QM1 Rooney assists veterans with determining what benefits they are entitled to, completing applications and obtaining referrals.
