## INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR HIGHWAY WORK PERMITS

**ALL** Highway Work Permits require Liability Insurance as follows:

The Permit Holder/Contractor must furnish the Town of Brookhaven with a Landlord's & Owner's policy or Homeowner's Liability policy naming the **Town of Brookhaven and Superintendent of Highways** as <u>ADDITIONAL INSUREDS</u> in the following amounts: \$100,000.00 and \$300,000.00 personal injury and \$50,000.00 property damage. If the Permit Holder/Contractor already has liability insurance, a certificate naming the **Town of Brookhaven and Superintendent of Highways** as <u>ADDITIONAL INSUREDS</u> for the same amounts is required.

**IF** you are using your contractor's insurance, the contractor must provide the above certificate of insurance <u>and</u> a letter on the company letterhead authorizing you to use their insurance. We must have the original of the letter, it cannot be faxed.
