Community Spotlights



On April 22, Jane, Councilman Michael Loguercio and members of the Coram Civic Association were on-hand when the Town demolished the vacant and abandoned Swap and Shop on Middle Country Road in Coram. The derelict building had remained vacant for over 20 years and was the source of resident complaints leading to numerous Town of Brookhaven building code violations. It was demolished in accordance with Chapter 73 of the Town Code which provides a “fast track” to rid the Town of unsafe structures.



On April 28, Jane and Supervisor Romaine attended a presentation of “Proudly We Served” at Leisure Glen in Ridge. The event was organized by Mary Ann Fox, who created the 112-page book “Proudly We Serve,” featuring interviews with veterans from World War II, the Korean War, the Cold War era and the Vietnam War.



On April 27, Jane joined the Mount Sinai Harbor Advisory Committee and more than 100 local community volunteers for the annual William Waltz Mount Sinai Harbor and Cedar Beach Clean Up.
