13th Annual Great Brookhaven Cleanup scheduled for May 16, 2020!

Last year over 3,000 Brookhaven residents joined 550,000 volunteers in more than 15,000 communities across America to pick up nearly 23.4 million pounds of litter and debris, beautify 81,000 miles of roadway, and clean up rivers, lakes and seashores in their communities. PROCEDURES FOR CLEAN-UP

NO YARD WASTE OR HOME CLEANUPS

DO NOT include yard waste, brush or leaves in your cleanup, as these materials cannot be collected under this program.

Your own property cleanup is also **not** included under this program.

BEFORE YOU CLEAN

Pick up your “TO GO PACK” during normal business hours:

- 9am – 4:30pm from May 4th to May 15th, 2020 or
- Tuesday evening, May 12th from 4:30pm – 8:30pm or
- Wednesday evening, May 13th from 4:30pm – 8:30pm
at Brookhaven Town Hall, 3rd Floor

Department of Recycling and Sustainable Materials Management.

Your “TO GO PACK” should include:

- Keep Brookhaven Beautiful T-Shirt
- Bags
- Stickers to identify bags
- Gloves
- Picker
- Participation certificates

ON CLEANUP DAY:

Things to bring... in addition to your **cell phone** and **“To Go Pack”**:

First aid Kit

Sunscreen

Sunglasses

Bug spray

Rain gear

Rakes

Shovels

Snacks/drinks

Hand cleaner

Report to your cleanup site and follow safety guidelines.

Bags will be collected at the site you designated on your registration form beginning Monday May 18th through Friday, May 22nd.

NOTE: DO NOT bring your bags home with you. Please leave them at the cleanup site you reported during registration, marked with stickers provided, so that we can collect and weigh them for the national report.

BECAUSE WE CARE ABOUT YOU...

We want to keep you safe!

- Wear light colored clothing that covers arms and legs.
- Wear substantial footwear, boots, etc. and watch your footing.
- Park all vehicles on the side of the road that's being cleaned.
- Carpool to the site to reduce the number of vehicles in the area.
- Work one side of the road at a time.
- Face oncoming traffic.
- Stay at least 5 feet from the edge of the road.
- Furnish adequate supervision by one or more adults (21 years or older) for groups that include participants under age 17.
- Work only during daylight hours.
- Discontinue work in inclement weather.
- Be alert to stinging insects, especially ticks.
- Be alert to poisonous plants.
- Don't wear clothing or apparatus that might impair vision or hearing.
- Don't wear clothing or display material that might distract motorists.
- Keep cell phones handy.
- Do not work alone.

SPECIAL NOTE...

Do not remove heavy or hazardous objects (couches, mattresses, syringes, unidentifiable liquids). Report them and they will be collected by Town crews later.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY...

- Have a first aid kit readily available.
- Know the route from your clean-up location to the nearest emergency room or hospital.
- Have transportation immediately available.
