Community Spotlights



On February 4, the Town demolished a home on Watermill Way in Ridge. The long-abandoned house was the source of resident complaints leading to numerous Town of Brookhaven housing code violations. It was demolished in accordance with Chapter 73 of the Town Code which provides a “fast track” to rid neighborhoods of unsafe structures.



On February 10, Jane, Supervisor Ed Romaine and the Town Council accepted a \$2,000 check from, Brad Calhoun, President and CEO of Teachers Federal Credit Union (TFCU) to co-sponsor the Town’s 2020 recycling events. This is the sixth consecutive year that TFCU has partnered with the Town. Each year the Town holds recycling events that include paper shredding, e-waste disposal and a supervised prescription drug drop-off program in every Brookhaven Council District.



On February 26, Jane hosted Suffolk County Sheriff, Errol Toulon Jr., for a discussion about the programs and initiatives within his department. The discussion highlighted the Project Lifesaver, Human Trafficking, Sandy Hook Promise, and Shed the Meds initiatives. Price

The price of the seasonal sticker is \$15.00 for Town of Brookhaven residents. The price for a non-resident seasonal sticker is \$250.00.

Discount

If purchased prior to Monday, May 18, 2020 the sticker cost is \$10.00.

Seniors, Handicapped Residents and Veterans

The price for a senior citizen (60+), handicapped resident or veteran is \$5.00

Disabled Veterans

Disabled veterans that are Brookhaven residents will receive a free sticker (must show United States Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) issued identification card stating "Service Connected" disability).
