DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, Edward P. Romaine, Supervisor of the Town of Brookhaven, pursuant to Article 2-B Section 24 of the New York State Executive law, hereby certify as follows:

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2020, the World Health Organization designated the novel coronavirus, COVID-19, outbreak as a Public Health Emergency of International Concern;

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, United States Health and Human Services Secretary Alex M. Azar II declared a public health emergency for the entire United States to aid the nation's healthcare community in responding to COVID-19;

WHEREAS, cases of transmission of COVID-19 have been documented in the Town of Brookhaven and more are expected to continue; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Brookhaven is addressing the threat that COVID-19 poses to the health and welfare of its residents and visitors.


WHEREAS, the State of New York by Executive Order No. 202 dated March 7, 2020, has addressed the transmission of the cases of COVID-19.

1. The Executive Order dated June 30, 2020, extended and/or amended on July 10, 2020, July 17, 2020, July 21, 2020, July 31, 2020, August 5, 2020, August 17, 2020 and August 25, 2020, September 2, 2020, and September 17, 2020 is hereby extended, provision 3c is extended and provision 3 is further modified to add provision "y" as follows:
  - 3c. All events that have been issued a parade and/or amusement permit are cancelled through November 1, 2020.
  - 3y. Haunted houses are hereby permitted provided the host/applicant strictly adheres to the low risk indoor entertainment guidelines set forth under Phase 4 by the State of New York at <https://www.governor.ny.gov/sites/governor.ny.gov/files/atoms/files/LowRiskIndoorArtsEntertainmentSummary.pdf> and provided that the haunted house host/applicant submits a business affirmation and safety plan to the State of New York, set forth at [https://www.governor.ny.gov/sites/governor.ny.gov/files/atoms/files/NYS\\_BusinessReopeningSafetyPlanTemplate.pdf](https://www.governor.ny.gov/sites/governor.ny.gov/files/atoms/files/NYS_BusinessReopeningSafetyPlanTemplate.pdf)

Haunted houses are hereby exempt from the requirement to obtain an amusement permit pursuant to §4-4 of the Brookhaven Town Code, from the date of this Executive order through November 30, 2020.

2. The Executive Orders regarding outdoor eateries and drive-in establishments, dated June 11, 2020, extended and/or amended on July 10, 2020, July 17, 2020, July 21, 2020, July 31, 2020, August 5, 2020, August 17, 2020, August 25, 2020, September 2, 2020 and September 17, 2020, are hereby extended.
