

Councilwoman Bonner Leads Clean Up of Town Property in Mount Sinai

Farmingville, NY - On May 4, Councilwoman Jane Bonner (left) joined staff from the Town's Department of Waste Management to help clean up Town owned property on Canal Road in Mount Sinai. More than 120,300 pounds of trash and debris was collected and removed from the site, which is not easily accessible from the road. The property has been plagued by illegal dumpers for years, and after members of the Mount Sinai Civic Association contacted the Councilwoman, she took action and worked with the Department Waste Management to schedule the clean up. In 2014, the Town performed over 600 roadside clean ups at a cost of \$800,000. This does not include work done on private property.

Councilwoman Bonner said, "I cannot understand how people think they can just dump their trash anywhere they like. It's a problem in every community and I urge anyone who sees it happening to report it to the Town. This property

has now been cleaned up thanks to the diligence of the Mount Sinai residents and our Waste Management staff, and I hope it stays that way."
