To become an Eagle Scout, a scout must earn a minimum of 21 merit badges, demonstrate leadership, and perform an approved community service project. For John Clancy's Eagle Scout project, he beautified the Miller Place-Mount Sinai Historical Society. Jack Harrington built picnic benches at Saint Anthony's High School. Sean Harrington built two picnic tables and benches for the St. Louis de Montfort Roman Catholic Church. Andrew Holomshek cleared the growth and fallen tree limbs from the Phillip & Davis Cemetery and spread mulch to help prevent regrowth. John Kostic restored and renovated an outdoor atrium at Stony Brook Hospital. Kevin Palmer replaced the front steps to the historic Daniel Hawkins House.
