## *Selden resident begins his first term on Brookhaven Town Board*

**Farmingville, NY** - On January 7, Councilman Kevin LaValle was sworn in during a ceremony held in the auditorium at Brookhaven Town Hall. The Councilman, who was elected to office in November 2013, represents Council District 3, which includes Lake Grove, Centereach, Selden, and parts of Lake Ronkonkoma, Farmingville and Coram. He was recently assigned by Supervisor Ed Romaine to serve as Town Board Liaison to the Highway Department, Traffic Safety/Street Lighting and the Pennysaver Amphitheatre, which is located in his district. Councilman LaValle will focus on addressing local land-use and building concerns, repair of local streets and making government run more efficiently.

"It is an honor to be given the opportunity to serve the residents of Council District 3," said Councilman LaValle. "Having lived and worked for an elected representative in this district, I have a unique perspective on the needs and concerns of my neighbors and I look forward to helping improve the quality of life for everyone. I will work side-by-side with Supervisor Romaine and my colleagues on the Town Board to make Brookhaven Town a better place to live now and for generations to come."

Prior to his election, Councilman LaValle worked for former Suffolk County Legislator Daniel Losquadro as his Chief of Staff for three years before he became President and part-owner of Pinnacle Title Agency from 2007-2011. Most recently he served as a Legislative Aide to Suffolk County Legislator Thomas Muratore. He is also a licensed loan mortgage originator and works for Lynx Mortgage Bank. He specializes in working with first time homebuyers. Councilman LaValle's experience in both the public and private sector has given him the expertise needed to implement the goals and themes of a Town Board that is focused on governmental reform.

Councilman LaValle was raised in Centereach and currently resides in Selden. He is a graduate of Centereach High School and earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree with a major in political science from Salisbury University.
