Cartright attended one of the Town of Brookhaven's annual E-Waste and Paper Shredding Events at the Setauket Fire Department Main Street Firehouse. This event allows residents to properly dispose of electronics, including televisions, computers, cell phones and office machines, so they may be safely recycled. Shredding of paper documents was also done on site, and over 200 households participated.

"We did just over 200 cars, which was by far the most successful summertime shred we have ever offered," stated Steven Innerfield, CSDS, of Quality Shredding.
