Farmingville, NY – Brookhaven Town Councilman Dan Panico was joined by Supervisor Ed Romaine and fellow board members in paying special tribute to Moriches resident Bobby Lenahan, for his invention of IV Hero, a thoughtful and innovative product that covers intravenous bags with superhero characters. Bobby created IV Hero with hopes that it would make hospital stays and medical treatments for children less intimidating. To date, IV Hero is currently being used in the pediatric departments at South Nassau Community Hospital, Northwell Staten Island University, and NYU Langone Medical Center. His IV Hero also won first place in the Regional Division of the New York Business Plan Competition for New York State College students.

Bobby – a 2013 graduate of William Floyd High School – is a junior at Molloy college where is studying accounting. Bobby has also been an active member and volunteer of the Moriches Bay Civic Association.
