

Councilman Panico and Brookhaven Town Board Honor William Floyd Summit Beautification Committee

Farmingville, NY – At the September 17 Town Board meeting, Councilman Dan Panico, Supervisor Ed Romaine and fellow Town Board members paid special recognition to the volunteer members of the William Floyd Summit Beautification Committee for their dedicated efforts in beautifying the Tri-Hamlet communities of Mastic, Mastic Beach and Shirley.

Since being established, the committee has conducted numerous beautification projects, including the renovation of the corner of William Floyd Parkway and Montauk Highway with walkways, gardens and bushes, as well as the installation of a statue of William Floyd. In addition, volunteers have planted more than 50,000 flowering bulbs throughout the community, created a bird sanctuary on Mastic Road in Mastic Beach, and placed commemorative bronze plaques throughout the three hamlets.

Councilman Panico praised the Beautification Committee and officially thanked them for their hard work with Certificates of Recognition.
