The project was completed as part of Connor’s Star Scout rank advancement. To attain Star ranking, a Scout must perform six hours of service to others. The Blue Point Nature Preserve was constructed by the Town on a 20 acre site that was formerly occupied by a nursery, but had been vacant for many years. The park includes a walking path throughout, benches and a pergola.
