

Brookhaven Town Removes Over 1,500 Illegal Signs From Right-of-Ways and Utility Poles

Farmingville, NY - Supervisor Ed Romaine, Councilman Dan Panico, Councilwoman Connie Kepert and Councilman Neil Foley recently visited the Brookhaven Landfill to mark the one year anniversary of the Town's Illegal Road Sign law. In his 2014 State of the Town address, Supervisor Romaine proposed strengthening of the Town's existing code to ban all signs on Town public right-of-ways and on utility poles. That legislation was unanimously adopted by the Town Board. Since its adoption, the Town's Waste Management, Parks and Law departments have collected more than 1,500 illegal signs.
