Farmingville, NY - On September 30, Brookhaven Town Councilman Dan Panico announced that he has partnered with the Long Island Housing Partnership, Inc. (LIHP) to provide a housing seminar on October 24, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. in the LIG room at the William Floyd High School. This seminar will offer residents an opportunity to gain knowledge about housing programs and other resources available to them.

Councilman Panico encourages residents to attend the seminar and take advantage of the services offered by the LIHP, emphasizing that they have homes available for immediate ownership for those who qualify, and certified counselors who can assist families that are having trouble making their mortgage payments.

Additional housing programs available through the LIHP include Down Payment Assistance, Home Emergency Mortgage Assistance Program (HEMAP), the Employer Assisted Housing Program and the Rehabilitation Emergency Assistance Program (REAP), which provides grants for making a home handicapped accessible.
