

Panico Secures Agreement Between Town of Brookhaven and Newly Formed Village of Mastic Beach

Farmingville, NY - At the April 5 Town Board meeting, Councilman Panico carried a resolution to enter into an Inter-municipal Agreement between the Town of Brookhaven and the newly formed Incorporated Village of Mastic Beach to utilize the Town of Brookhaven's Nutrition Center as the new Village Court.

The Incorporated Village of Mastic Beach (Village) is in need of a suitable building to be used as a Village Court on a twice monthly basis. Councilman Panico firmly supports cooperation between the Town of Brookhaven and the Incorporated Village of Mastic Beach in carrying out respective responsibilities. The Village will have to pay a "per use" fee.

"As the Councilman for the entire area that encompasses the Village, I look forward to working in a mutually beneficial manner with the Village officials just as I do with other levels of government like Suffolk County," commented Brookhaven Town Councilman Dan Panico. "As a person who grew up in Mastic Beach and a William Floyd grad, I am particularly interested in making sure that my hometown realizes its full potential and will do everything I can to work cooperatively with the Village as they move forward."
