

Councilman Panico Moves Resolution to Allow Osprey Pointe Civic Association to Adopt Land Parcel

Farmingville, NY - At its August 17th meeting the Brookhaven Town Board approved a resolution put forward by Councilman Dan Panico of the Sixth Council District allowing the Osprey Pointe Civic Association to adopt and maintain the triangular parcel of land located at the corners of Grassmere Drive, Shore Drive, and Park Place in Mastic Beach.

The purpose of the resolution was to allow the Civic Association to take on responsibility for the clean up and maintenance of the parcel as a natural wooded area within the community, as the area had become a dumping ground for garbage and other inappropriate activities.

"In the short time since their creation, the Osprey Point Civic Association has made a difference in their community. This group of civic-minded neighbors have not only spearheaded the local neighborhood watch they pursued the preservation and maintenance of the Town of Brookhaven Osprey Park. Now with the passage of this resolution the Osprey Park Civic Association has again demonstrated a proactive and caring stance for their community and neighbors" stated Councilman Dan Panico.

Councilman Panico had recently met with Frank Cappiello, the Osprey Pointe Civic Association's President to discuss various community issues and the Civics' continued commitment to work on improving the quality of life in the Mastic Beach area.
