The donation for this fun-filled event is \$30 for adults, \$20 for juniors 12 years and younger and \$10 for non-bowlers, and includes unlimited bowling, shoe rental, buffet and dessert. The Brookhaven Ecology Site, Park and Animal Preserve is located at 249 Buckley Road in Holtsville on a reclaimed landfill. Since 1974, the Town of Brookhaven Highway Department has worked to revegetate the hills there, building a modern recreational and educational facility. Some of the amenities at the park include an exercise-trail fitness course; nature preserve and ecology center featuring buffalo, bobcats, eagles, ecology exhibits and tours; free compost; greenhouses, and a picnic area. The Ecology Site and Animal Preserve is open Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., and weekends from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. For more information, visit www.brookhaven.org or call 758-9664.
