Minimum Planting Requirements

6 Trees and 15 Shrubs per 1,000 Square Feet of ground disturbance

Tree (4 to 6 feet in height), Shrub (18 to 24 Inch Height), Ground Cover (1.5 square feet)

Native Plants are drought tolerant compared to nonnative species, and are adapted to our local environment, maintain natural ecological diversity, perpetuate fast disappearing native genotypes and comprise of habitat restoration.
