

Town Swearing In Ceremony Postponed Until Tuesday, January 7 Due to Impending Snow

Farmingville, NY - Brookhaven Town Supervisor Edward P. Romaine has announced that the swearing in ceremony which was scheduled for Thursday at 4:30 pm at Brookhaven Town Hall has been postponed due to the impending snow storm. The new date is Tuesday, January 7 at 3:00 pm.

Supervisor Romaine said, "All reports are predicting snow on Thursday, and we will be asking residents to stay off the roads for their safety and to allow our snow removal crews to do their jobs. Moving the swearing in ceremony is the prudent thing to do in light of the hazardous conditions that are expected."

"My focus is to keep Brookhaven Town roads safe," Superintendent Daniel P. Losquadro said. "I am happy the swearing in ceremony has been moved to a later date so I can remain in constant contact with my administration and crews out on our roads during a time of predicted inclement weather. I want to thank Supervisor Romaine for changing this date and sharing in my priority to put safety first."
