

Supervisor Romaine and Councilman LaValle Encourage Residents to Use On-line Form to Report Excessive Noise and More at Long Island MacArthur Airport

Farmingville, NY - At a recent meeting of the Brookhaven-Long Island MacArthur Airport Committee, Councilman Kevin LaValle announced that the Town has established an online form for residents to report airport noise. Now residents who are impacted by excessive noise from planes landing or taking off from Long Island MacArthur Airport can easily file a complaint by going to www.brookhaven.org and clicking on "Committees" in the menu.

"Living near an airport becomes more than just an inconvenience when planes fly low," said Supervisor Ed Romaine. "The loud noise that people must endure is a real quality of life issue and totally unacceptable. Residents who have a complaint should file it immediately online so the Town can be made aware of any incident as soon as it occurs."

"Those who live in the flight path of Long Island MacArthur Airport are subject to a daily barrage of airplane noise and sometimes it can be unreasonably loud," said Councilman LaValle. "Residents now have a direct line to the Town where they can file a noise complaint and receive a response. I urge anyone who experiences loud or low flying planes, excessive vibrations, too early or late planes and more, to go online and submit a completed form."

The Brookhaven-Long Island MacArthur Airport Committee was created by Town Resolution sponsored by Supervisor Romaine in June 2013. It is an advocate for Brookhaven residents whose quality of life is negatively impacted by the operations of Long Island Mac Arthur Airport.
