

# Supervisor Romaine and Councilman Panico Honored as Heroes of the Bay by Moriches Bay Project

**Farmingville, NY** – Brookhaven Town Supervisor Ed Romaine and Councilman Dan Panico were recently honored by the Moriches Bay Project (MBP) for their outstanding support of the environmental and educational nonprofit organizations. MBP works to improve the water quality in Moriches Bay through oyster farming and eel grass plantings and has partnered with several municipalities, including Brookhaven Town, in their endeavors. Specifically, the Town has supplied MBP with thousands of oysters which have been placed in Moriches Bay in waters located at Moriches Yacht Club in Center Moriches and in the Forge River. Because of their commitment to MBP and its mission to plant one million mollusks in the bay, Supervisor Romaine and Councilman Panico were named official Heroes of the Bay. MBP also recognized Tom Carrano of the Town's Division of Environmental Protection for his role in facilitating and

coordinating delivery and placement of oysters to various locations.
