

Town of Brookhaven Ocean Beaches at Davis Park and Great Gun Closed Until Further Notice Due to Tropical Storm Hermine

Farmingville, NY – Supervisor Ed Romaine has announced that the Town's ocean beaches at Davis Park and Great Gun will be closed until further notice. The action was taken in anticipation of Tropical Storm Hermine, which is expected to cause heavy surf, rip currents and flooding along Fire Island starting on Sunday morning and continuing through Tuesday. Heavy rains and gusty winds are also forecasted.

Residents should call 451-TOWN to report downed trees and other storm related issues. Call 911 for police, fire and ambulance emergencies only. To report a power outage or downed wires, call PSEG at 800-490-0075 or go to www.psegliny.com to file a report online.
